## MRS. T. FAULCONER PASSES

Tennessee Native Succumbs at Home  
of Daughter at Schofield.

CORNELIUS, Or., Oct. 23.—(Special.)  
—Mrs. Tennessee Faulconer, after an illness of two months, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. H. M. Drorbaugh, at Schofield, Monday.

Mrs. Faulconer was born in Shelby County, Tennessee, January 20, 1847, and in 1865 was married to J. W. Wakes, who died December 23, 1875. In 1892 she was married to A. B. Faulconer, a pioneer of 1847, at Sheridan, Or., and lived there until Mr. Faulconer's death in 1899. Since then she has made her home for the greater part of the time with her daughter, and was well known in Cornelius and Forest Grove.

“FAULCONER, A. B.--Born in Kentucky in 1816; came from Missouri to Oregon; settled in the Willamette Valley and took up a claim near Sheridan, on which he still lives. In 1840 he married Miss Mary Graves, and by her had four children, two of whom, James and Anna, are living. Mrs. Faulconer died and he was married again to Mrs. Mary A. Cutting; has six children by her Mary, Estella, Hattie, Thomas, Edward, and Sheridan.” [History of the Willamette Valley by Lang p.656]

## Boy Brings Berries to Pioneer Friends

Absalom Faulconer was a pioneer of 1846, coming by the Applegate route. He later married and he and his wife settled near where the town of Sheridan now stands. Domestic help was very hard to get in the early days, so Mrs. Faulconer took a Chinese boy to do chores and learn to cook and make garden.

In a few years the Chinese wished to visit his old home in China, saying that he would return. Mrs. Faulconer did not expect to see him again, but one day he came in and held in his hand a package which he presented to Mrs. Faulconer with

the information that it was a very fine berry and grew profusely in China. There were, to the delight of the family, three sprouts of the berry that this boy had carefully tended all the way from China.

These were planted on the homestead where the Vic Gross harness shop now stands. As fast as new sprouts appeared they were given to friends. One was sent to Tillamook, to the Methodist preacher, who was stationed there, and the other to Marcellus Faulconer, a brother of Absalom, who lived on the Neskowin.

From these three plants this berry was scattered all over the state, especially along the coast in Tillamook and nearby counties, proving to be both friend and foe. The Chinese boy's home was in Korea, China.

## FUNERAL OF ABSALOM B. FAULCONER.



**SHERIDAN, Jan. 23.**—The funeral of Absalom B. Faulconer, who died here of the grip Friday, took place Sunday, under the auspices of the local lodge of Masons, of which deceased was a member. The interment was in the Masonic cemetery.

Mr. Faulconer was a pioneer of 1840, and was aged 82 years, 7 months and 10 days. He was born in Kentucky, June 10, 1810. His parents moved to Missouri in 1824. He was married in Missouri to Mary A. Graves, and the result of the union was five children, two of whom are still living—James B. Faulconer and Mrs. Helen A. Hussey. He started for Oregon in 1840, and was in the first train that came in by the Applegate cut-off, or Klamath lake and Rogue river route. In 1847 he settled where Sheridan now stands, taking up a donation claim. He became a member of the Christian church in the same year, and had been an esteemed member ever since. He built the first house in Sheridan, and for years kept it, not as a hotel, but rather as an open house free to all, for no one was ever turned away from his doors. His first wife died in 1854, and he was married the second time to Mrs. Mary A. Cutting. They had eight children, six of whom are still living—Mrs. Mary A. Thomas, of Whatcom; T. P. Faulconer and Mrs. Helen A. Hunt, of Chihuahua, Mexico; Ed N. Faulconer, of Tacoma; Sheridan Faulconer and Estella Worthington, of El Paso, Tex. His second wife died March 12, 1880, and after her death he twice married. His last wife, formerly Mrs. Tena Nokes, survives him.
