"Mrs. Riley Andrus--Dayton, July 25, Mrs. Orphelia Mattoon Andrus was born September 7, 1850, at Oregon City, and died July 22, 1928, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. James Wakefield in Dayton, at the age of 77.

In 1869 she was married to Riley Andrus. They had seven children, of whom the following survive: Alva Andrus of Gaston, Orvai Andrus of Monmouth, Mrs. Eloise Miller of Gaston, Nelson Andrus of Roseburg, Mrs. J. A. Wakefield of Dayton and Mrs.

Myrtle Thomas of Portland. Mrs. Andrus had been a member of the Christian church for more than 40 years. They came to Dayton from Roseburg in 1905. Funeral services were held at the Christian church Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock conducted by the Rev. L. G. Parks. Burial was in the I. O. O. F. cemetery."
