

Henry Martindale was brought in Tuesday from Camas valley where he accidently shot himself in the right leg on last Saturday and is now at the residence of Mrs. A. Zook near the depot where he will receive medical treatment

Saturday afternoon Drs. Houck and Hoover, with Dr. F. W. Haynes to administer the anasthetics, amputated the right leg of Henry Martindale, just below the knee. Mr. Martindale is the man, who was accidentally shot at Camas Valley a short time ago. He is now getting along nicely at the residence of Mrs. V. C. London, in this city.
