She was born six miles west of Junction City June 21, 1850, making her home in and near that place until 1908, when she moved to Salem. She was married to Benjamin Hyland in 1865 and he died in 1890. To this union were born seven children, of whom five survive, as follows: Mrs. Jane Henderson and Mrs. Emma Ingram of Junction City, Fred and Charles Hyland of Salem, and Mrs. Bertha Swift of Vaughn.

Services will be held at the Clough-Huston chapel in Salem at 1 P. M. Sunday, with interment in the Junction City Odd Fellows' cemetery at 4 P. M.

**AMOS DAMON HYLAND**—Was born in Plainfield, Will county, Illinois, February 11, 1837, and there resided until the spring of 1852, at which time he accompanied his father and two brothers across the plains to Oregon, where they arrived in November of the same year. Mr. Hyland first was variously employed in day's labor; in 1853, however, he came to Lane county and located at Junction City, where he engaged in farming until the spring of 1874, when selling out he purchased his present stock farm of two thousand four hundred and fifty acres, and his residence, of which and its surroundings, an excellent view appears in this work, being situated at the junction of the Oregon Central Military road and that leading from Springfield, where he is engaged in general farming, stock-raising and hop-growing, besides being engaged in mercantile pursuits. He was married at Junction City in 1858 to Miss Rachel A. Crow, by which union they have ten surviving children, viz: Abbey A. (now Mrs. Albert E. McFarland), Noble G., Emma E., Minerva A., Ansell A., Seeley A., Carrie E., Estelle M., Ira D. and Ernest.

Grant, Ira B., Ernest and Wilbur Hyland, sons of deceased, are appointed executors without bonds. The estate consists of stock lands, timber lands, saw mills, notes, etc.**



“DIED -- Mrs. Maria Campbell, wife of Charles Campbell, died in this city at the residence of her mother Mrs. Louisa Hyland, at an early hour Wednesday morning, July 15, 1903, aged 35 years and 8 days. She leaves a husband and four children. Mrs. Campbell had been sick for months and while her death was not unexpected it was nevertheless a severe blow to the family. She was a member of the Degree of Honor of Eugene, and carried a policy of \$1,000. Services were held in the Christian Church Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock by Rev. Lobdell.
