MRS. SARAH E. SMITH IS DEAD

One of the Few Remaining Oregon Pioneer Women Passes to the Great Beyond

The reaper death has seen fit to remove from our midst another of Oregon's beloved pioneer women.

Mrs. Sarah E. Smith is no more. Death came last night at 12 o'clock after a lingering diness of a few weeks. Some time ago Mrs. Smith had an attack of grip, from which she never fully railied. For the past week she has been very feeble, but was not thought to be in a critical condition until yesterday, when she was taken with sinking spells and gradually lost consciousness and closed her eyes in death, as if she was in natural sleep.

Mrs. Sarah Smith was born in Virginia in 1829, and crossed the plains as Miss Sarah Craft in 1845. She is one of the few who remain who came by the Meeks cut-off. After enduring many hardships the party finally arrived in the Willamette valley, and Miss Craft settled with her relatives in East Salem, in what is now known as Watt addition. She was married in 1846 to Joseph Watt who for many years conducted a furniture factory in East Salem. To the union was born the following surviving children: James Watt, of Marshfield, Or.; Charles L. Watt and Elizabeth Watt, of this city, and George Watt, now of New York City.

Her husband, Joseph Watt, died, and she married Hon. Fabritis Smith and until his death in 1898 she resided on the Smith farm in South Salem. Since this date she has resided in the Watt addition near Fourteenth and Chemeketa streets, in this city.

She has been a devoted Christian all her life, and at the time of her death she was the oldest living member of the First M. E. church of this city. She was a sister of Mrs. Geo. P. Litchfield, of this city.
