James B. Buell, an early settler of Southern Oregon died at his home in this city. He was born at Wheeling, W. Virginia Oct.12,1841, and was 63 years 9 months and 19 days old at the time of his death. He came to Oregon in 1850 and settled on the North Fork between Dora and Fairview in 1870. In 1884, he moved to Curry County and in 1886 located on Catching Creek where he has resided until a few years ago when he came to Myrtle Point where he has since resided. Mr. Buell was united in marriage to Miss Florence Pearce Aug.6,1866[Douglas Co.] and 9 children was the result of this union- 5 of whom survive him: Julia A. Clarno; Mary E. Mrs. Sarah Braden after a brief illness, departed this life at her home in this city on Friday, the 9th inst., the funeral taking place (unreadable) and was conducted by Rev. Thos. Barklow. Sarah Caroline Braden was born in Cincinnati, Ohio, on Oct, 5, 1843, and was consequently 53 years and four days old at the time of her death. In company with her parents, she crossed the plains and settled in Oregon in 1852 near the present site of Roseburg. She was married to F. A. Braden on Feb. 24, 1864, the death of her husband occurring the 21st of January 1894. The family were among the oldest and most esteemed pioneers of this and Douglas Counties. F. A. Braden and his father built the first saw mill in Douglas County, which was located on Deer Creek near the present site of Roseburg, from which the lumber for the construction of some of the first buildings erected in Roseburg, was secured. After a residence of a few years, Douglas County they came to this county and were closely identified with it early development. However, they again returned to their old Douglas home and not until seven years ago did they again take up their residence in this county, where they resided up to the time of their respective deaths. An estimable family of seven children survive their sturdy, honored old pioneer parents, the loss of who is keenly felt by the whole community.

MLIITARY RITES GIVEN VETERAN

(Special to Coos Bay Times)

MYRTLE POINT, July 11 — A

military funeral for Alonzo Leonard Buell, 83 year old pioneer and
Civil War veteran was held here at
the Schroeder Chapel yesterday at
2 p. m. with Rev. Turner McDonald officiating.

Mr. Buell was born in Bueblo, Ohio and was six years old when he came to Oregon with his parents in the immigration train crossing the plains from Ohio in 1852. His family settled in wild uppopulated country, which is now Coos county, clearing land to make their farm and home. He lived there until he was 16, when he ventured into the business of freighting from the head of navigation on the Umpqua river to the miner's camps at Medford. He used a lumbering wooden wheeled wagon, drawn by oxen, and successfully continued his freighting trips, often molested by maurauding Indians, until the time of the Civil War. He was 18 when he enlisted at Vancouver for active service in the Oregon territory fighting the Indians. It was during the year of 1864 when he joined, and a year later he was honorably discharged after fighting in campaigns covering Harney county and Grand Ronde valley.

Four years later, Mr. Buell married Martha Livingston in Douglas county, and from this union four children were born, one of whom is now living, Mrs. Eva Neal of Hanford.

After his wife's death he was married to Nora Lee Neil in 1882 in Coos county. Ed. Bender, who was then justice of the peace, officiated at the ceremony. Two children were born to this union.

For a few years Mr. Buell farmed and then moved to California where he remained a year. Although the white people and Indians were at peace, the women were often molested by theiving red men who brandished knives in order to frighten them into giving them food, knowing that there was no means of protection for miles when the men were away from home.

After a year, he and his family a returned to Oregon, where they have lived since that time. Until trecently Mr. Buell has actively full cultivated his gardens each year, hand was interested in the Clvil War Veteran's Post here. His death occurred shortly following a stroke of paralysis.

There were twelve brothers and sisters in his family, only three of whom survive his death. They are Julia Williams, living in Myrtle Point; Mary Jones, who lives in Washington; and Alman Buell, who is in Roseburg. There are two children, Mrs. Eva Neal of Hanford, and Mrs. Chloe Holden of Salem. Both of them attended the funeral, are here now. He also has eleven grand-children, and thirteen great-grandchildren.

The funeral was under the auspices of the American Legion and G. A. R., and the Oddfellows lodge at Roseburg, where he has been a member of 50 years standing, was notified. Interment was held at the Catching Creek cemetery.
