

Another pioneer, in the person of James H. Wurren, who has been a familiar personage in this part of castern Washington, was laid away in the Asotin cemetery last Friday afternoon-having died in White's hospital in Lewiston on Tuesday before, death being due to old age and kidney trouble.

James H. Warren was born in Fulton county, Illinois, 82 years ago last May, or in 1836. In 1853, at the age of 17, he came west to Oregor, and located in the Willamette valley where the city of Eugene now stands, before there was any Eugene. During the exciting days of gold mining in the Boles basin he and his brother, E. L. Warren-four years his senior-made their way to Nation's gulch, in the vicinity of old Bannock (ity, where placer mining was followed for nearly two years. Those were great days, as he has often referred to them, and he used to take out \$8.00 in gold dust from a single showl of dirt; and he and his brother frequently cleaned up \$500 in a single day. But those were days of a wonderful past, when riches came quickly and went as easily, and nothing particularly thought of it.

In all, about 20 years were spent in Oregon, and about two years after the palmy days spent in the placer fields of south Idaho, he came to the Asotin section and the past 35 or 40 years have been spent in this part of the northwest. For many years, in a favored spot along Snake river, a few miles from Asotin, he devoted his time to fruit raisingraising a good quality of fruit and ulways much earlier than any other part of this favored spot of the west.

Mr. Warren never married. For the past five years his health was quite poor, but until a few weeks ago he was able to get ubout, and only a few days ago was shaking hands with Asotia friends. He leaves one brother, E. L. Warren, who has quarters in the Soldiera' Home at Retsil; and one sister, Mrs. Ruth Bridges, residing at Whittier, California.—Asotin County Sentinel, Asotin, Wash.
