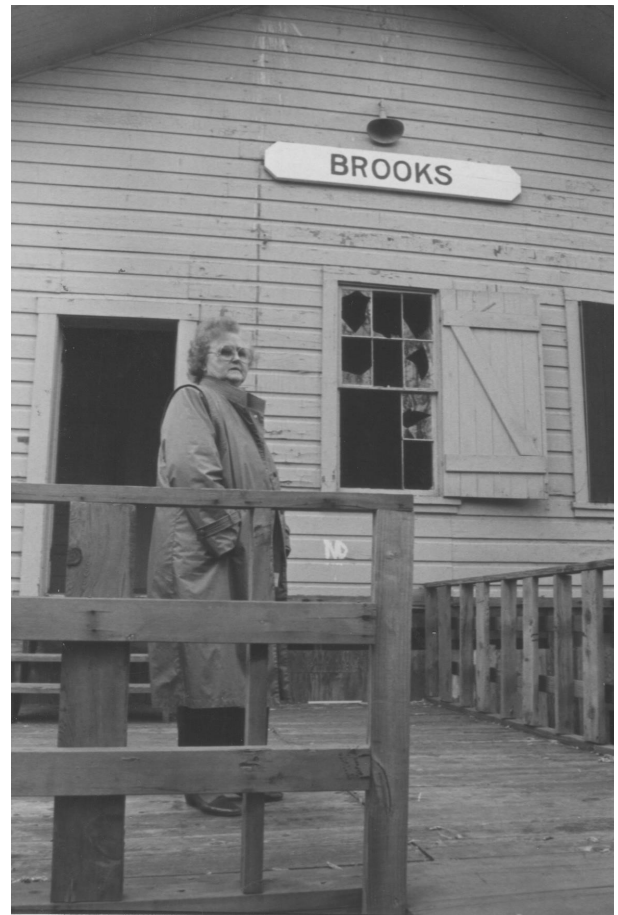
who were studying local history.

Her energy and vision resulted in her overseeing the Brooks Southern Pacific Railroad Depot moved to the grounds of



Antique Powerland in 1989. It was the first museum building on Powerland grounds, now called Powerland Heritage Park.

She also oversaw much of the renovation of the Depot. Lena held many offices on the board of directors of Brooks Historical Society and led many projects.



Later, she became our official Ambassador to the community, making many contacts in the Society's name. We profoundly appreciate her 30 years of vision and support.

## **In Memory of Robert “Bob” E. Brown July 25, 1929 – Jan. 8, 2017**



A long-time member and friend of Brooks Historical Society passed away January 8. Bob served in several positions on the Board of Directors, most recently as Vice-President and then as Director.

He volunteered his woodworking skills as well, to further BHS projects. Bob donated his childhood model train, which is now a featured display in the agent's office of the Brooks Depot Museum.

Bob was a world recognized entomologist who retired from the Oregon State Department of Agriculture. He was a gentleman farmer who always took the time to help others. He enjoyed gardening, farming, raising honey bees, and fishing. He was very active in other community organizations as well as Brooks Historical Society. We will miss him.

It provides a look into farm home life in the 1910-1930 era. This is about the time frame of many of the antique power machines
